Location – Old U.S. Route 50 in three locations: near Summerfield from U.S. 50 east to Clinton County Line Road, from just east of Trenton to Koch Lane in Breese, and from just west of Bartelso Road in Beckemeyer to the west end of Carlyle.

June 30, 2010- The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that there will be lane closures on Old U.S. 50 from U.S. 50 near Summerfield to just west of Carlyle beginning Tuesday, July 6, 2010, weather permitting. These lane closures are necessary to replace pavement, widen pavement, resurface, and perform guardrail improvements. Please use caution when travelling through this area. It is estimated that these project activities will be completed by November 30, 2010. Signing and traffic control devices will be provided to aid motorists through the work zones. This work is being done by Christ Brothers Asphalt of Lebanon, Illinois. Steve Putz is the Supervising Field Engineer for the Illinois Department of Transportation in this area.
